Mrs Taylor Well, hurry up. We are waiting for you. (*wait*) Why are you so late every morning? (*get up*)

Mandy All right. I am coming now. (*come*)

4 Ben Can you play tennis tomorrow evening?

Jim No, I can't. I go to my karate lessons on Tuesday evenings. (*go*)

Ben Karate? Where are you going? (*do*)

Jim In a building behind the post office.

5 Sam Hello, Mrs Bell. We are waiting for Peter. Can he play football with us in the park? (*look*)

Mrs Bell Well, Peter can't go with you. He is doing his homework. (*do*)

6 Jim Where's Ben?

Mandy He's in the kitchen. He is washing up.

Jim Does he wash up every day? (*wash up*)

Mandy No, he doesn't. I wash up on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. (*wash up*) and Ben washes up it on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays. (*do*)
