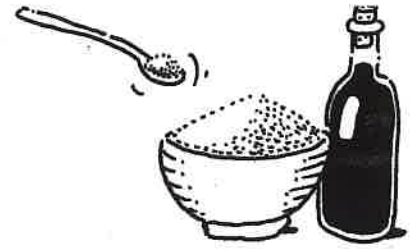


Opposites
